

Northern Territory

Currently euthanasia remains illegal in the Northern Territory but was briefly legal in 1995 when the Territory passed an act called the 'Rights of the Terminally Ill Act 1995' which legalised euthanasia in the NT. However, this act was nullified in 1997 by the federal Parliament of Australia which passed the Euthanasia Laws Act 1997.
