

## **United Kingdom**

The United Kingdom does not currently have any type of euthanasia or voluntary assisted suicide legalised but it is currently debating a couple Bills. One was introduced in January 2020 by Lord Falconer Thoroton, and another was introduced in May 2021 by Baroness Meacher.
